Library Hours:

Library Orientation

User education programmes are also organized to create awareness of the databases, published materials and develop skills in the use of the Knowledge Resource Centre

Granthotsay and Book Exhibitions

Granthotsav is arranged every year as well as book exhibitions are arranged during the year inviting dealers and publishers to display books for sale. Members can obtain resources at concessional rates during such exhibitions.

Lending Facilities

Extensive lending facilities for staff and students and for members of the community Inter Library loan facilities

Renewal

A member is allowed to renew books and other material issued for up to two times unless it has been reserved by another user by sending an email before the due date

Claims

An item currently on loan to another user can be reserved by placing a claim. A reserved item is subject to recall once it has been on loan for ten days.

Overnight Issue

Old magazines can be borrowed on Reference for overnight. Borrowing facility is available after 4.00pm. The magazines issued should be returned the next day by 11.00am. Failing a

B. ICT based Practices: -

Online Public Access Catalogue (OPAC)

The KRC is fully automated. The Knowledge Resource Centre uses SLIM software for OPAC It gives detailed information about the sources including books, journals, e-journals, and databases with different search tools for its users. BMK-KRC is using Ouriginal software for plagiarism checking.

SDI (Selective Dissemination of Information)

An info alert service is available for faculty members. Faculty members are given daily updates on current affairs in their respective domains.

Video Screening

The library arranges for screening of films every quarter.

TOC of the day

The contents page of new journal arrived are scanned daily and mailed to faculty members.

Question Papers online

Question Papers are made available online. The link to access is available through digital repository or on library machines.

CAS (Current Awareness Service)

Every month a list of additions to the library collection is made available online to the HOD's.

JAWS software for blind

For visual impaired students BMK-KRC use JWAS software.

Computer Lab.

BMK-KRC is providing computer laboratory facility to its members to access online resources.
