About the College :

Leelabai Thackeray college of nursing is a professional college and a constituent college of S.N.D.T Women's University. The college was established as a department in 1952 and raised to a full fledged college in 1964. It was recognized by the Maharashtra nursing council in 1965 and the recognition was confirmed by the government of Maharashtra in 1966 and by Indian Nursing council in 1969. The college started a two years post graduate program leading to Masters in nursing in the year 1976 and Doctorate program in nursing in 1993. The college also conducts the one year Neonatal nursing . The education program of nursing is recognized by the Indian Nursing Council.

Objectives :

1. To provide education to girls and women whose access to it is limited or poor. This includes those who are located in remote areas, those who are bound by orthodoxy and societal inhibitions, those whose education has been cut short for various reason, and those who are restricted by financial constraints.
2. To provide courses so as to ensure that women gain entry into fields from which they have been traditionally excluded.
3. To identify where and what kind of new job opportunities are appearing in the course of the on going industrialization and modernization of the country.
4. To consciously equip students to function as responsible citizens and self-confident and responsible individuals.
5. To advance the quality of education for women.

Health is the right of every citizen of the nation. The nursing profession contributes to the health goals at the hospital and community level. Nursing practice, based on value of caring, focuses on promotive, preventive, curative and rehabilitative care throughout the life span of the citizens, with an understanding of human behavior. The under graduate programme prepares graduates nurses to practice with skill and competency maintaining the code of ethics and professional conduct to meet the professional obligations and respond to the nations aspiration from them as exemplary citizens.
